## Dr. Michael Goldberg



Dr. Michael Goldberg is currently an Associate Professor in the Discipline of Periodontics at the University of Toronto's Faculty of Dentistry where he is the director of the Severe and Refractory Periodontal Disease Treatment Unit and the newly-formed Implant Monitoring Clinic.

He is engaged in an overall review of the influence of systemic, genetic and environmental factors on the development and treatment of periodontal disease. In addition, he is the head of the division of Periodontology as well as an associate in the Wasser Pain Management Centre at Mount Sinai Hospital in Toronto. Dr. Goldberg is also a partner in private specialty practice, limited to periodontics and implant surgery at Cumberland Periodontics in downtown Toronto.

Dr. Goldberg received his dental degree in 1991 from the University of Toronto after completing a Masters of Science in Pharmacology at the University of Toronto. Following a one year general practice residency at Mount Sinai Hospital in Toronto, he entered the Department of Periodontics at the University of Toronto, graduating in 1994.
